

Core Bus Corridors Blackrock to Merrion



There has been a lot of thinking and work on the best routes for bus corridors.

These are known as Emerging Preferred Routes.



One route goes from Blackrock to Merrion.

This bus corridor will start on the Merrion Road, at the junction with Nutley Lane.



The bus will travel along Rock Road joining the N31 at the Mount Merrion Avenue junction.



This bus corridor joins the UCD to City Centre bus corridor at the junction of Merrion Road and Nutley Lane.

This bus corridor ends at the junction of Temple Hill, Monkstown Road and Stradbroke Road.



Now, the bus journey from Blackrock to Merrion takes up to 30 minutes.

With the bus corridor, this journey will take up to 15 minutes.



The route is 4 kilometres.



There will be new cycle lanes along this route.



We need to make changes along the route to make room for the bus corridor.

For example, changing road layouts, making changes to some gardens. taking away parking spaces, taking down and replacing some trees,
